If you are interested, this medal is coming up for sale at Heritage Auctions on May 16, lot 93069. The GHL below the witch indicates the die was by George H. Lovett. Catalog number is Miller NY-491C. This was a popular image for numismatists in the nineteenth century. A line drawing of the medal was used by E. L. Mason in 1884 and by Luther B. Tuttle in 1894. The phrase “We All Have Our Hobbies” was used in advertising by Tuttle from 1897 to 1908.
